Strands and Elements	The members of the group further explored how the course might be structured under
	the headings of strands and elements. There was consensus reached on the titles of the
	strands and elements. The decision now sees the three strands as follows: Procedural
	Knowledge; Music in Context; and Exploring Ideas in Music. The elements are Creating
	and Imagining; Participating and Musicing (Making); and Responding and Appraising.
Learning Outcomes	The group were given the task of writing a set of learning outcomes for the strand
	concerned with foundational/procedural knowledge. A summary of the group feedback
	and ideas was compiled.
Classroom-Based Assessment 2	This classroom based assessment will take place towards the middle of third year. The
	main ideas for this revolved around writing programme notes for the upcoming
	performance assessment. These notes could include contextual information on the
	pieces and some information about the composers. Another idea mooted was a student
	reflection which would include why pieces were chosen, and how rehearsals and
	preparation progressed.
